**Joint Seminar - Findings in Liquidation Process and How to Help Your Team or Clients in Resolving Liquidity Issues (Course Code 2811)**

During the course of liquidation, liquidators frequently identified irregularities adopted by the company management to deceive the auditors/accountants and the public. When a distressed client goes burst, the auditors/accountants can be attacked by other stakeholders if significant irregularities are subsequently reported. In view of the potential reputation and litigation risk and liabilities, early detection of any of these irregularities and financial difficulties of these company management will enable the auditors/accountants to rectify the issues rather than letting the distressed company goes straight into liquidation. This seminar summarizes the commonly used fraudulent methods identified by the Liquidators and discusses the possible options to avoid corporate collapse.
