Highlights: 課程重點:	The COVID-19 pandemic has plunged the global economy into a severe contraction that many companies have incurred significant losses or even went bankrupt. Global corporate default rate is expected to rise and could result in higher probability of default. The exceptional circumstances surrounding the epidemic made the exercise of ECL assessment challenging.
