1. Hong Kong Tax Update

It will provide updates on the developments of Hong Kong taxation for the period from 1 July 2018 to 30 September 2019



Speaker: Mr. Patrick Ho, Tax Practitioner

Mr. Ho is the principal lecturer of FTMS Training Systems (HK) Limited. He is a professional accountant and a barrister-at-law. He has accumulated over 35 years of taxation and teaching experience from international accounting firms, Inland Revenue Department and universities. He is the author of "Hong Kong Taxation and Tax Planning".

Patrick holds a Bachelor degree in Law from University of London and a Master degree in Law and a MBA from The University of Hong Kong. He is currently a fellow member of the HKICPA.

2. Updates on "Tax & Fee Reduction Policy" in China

In view of the dynamic changes and challenges of global economy, China has continued to deepen her "tax and fee reduction policy (減稅降費政策)" to optimize business environment and facilitate economic development. In this session, we will highlight the key measures in 2019 in respect of the following taxes and fees:

- Enterprise Income Tax;
- Value Added Tax;
- Individual Income Tax; and
- Social Security Contributions.

4. Transfer Pricing

Transfer pricing has widely been perceived as one of the most complicated parts in tax practice. With the implementation of the Inland Revenue (Amendment) (No.6) Ordinance 2018, it is now compulsory for "large" Hong Kong corporations to prepare the transfer pricing documentation starting from the year 2019.

More importantly, based on our experience, we are aware that a number of Hong Kong corporations have not thoroughly assessed their transfer pricing risks in the past. As it is very difficult to revise the pricing strategy after the accounting yearend, it is essential to perform a health check this year before the preparation of the transfer pricing documentation next year.

The target audience of this seminar is accountants with limited experience in handling transfer pricing cases. The seminar will start with fundamental concept in transfer pricing and then followed by practical experience in handling transfer pricing documentation.
