# ACCA-XERO: DIGITISING THE ACCOUNTING AND AUDITING PROCESS FOR HONG KONG PRACTITIONERS

Digitalisation represents the greatest opportunity accountants have had to transform their businesses since the invention of the spread-sheet. Such innovations aren't only transforming ways of work, but they are also changing the role of the accountant itself. Practices that fail to adapt to those new ways of working run the risk of being left behind.

Eunice Chu, FCCA, Head of Policy, ACCA Hong Kong will share with you a newly launched report 'The passionate practitioner: Developing the digitalised small and medium practice' to explore the nature of that opportunity, set out the components of the business case and a potential implementation path.

Today, providers of modern accounting software have developed solutions that integrate with banks and in-store systems to collect data right from when transactions occur, and flows seamlessly through accounting software and other business apps.

Andrew Yung from Xero will show how these data flows in action, and see how 'real-time' auditing is made possible when your practice is digitised in the cloud.
